There is no registration fee; however, the travel and accommodation costs are not covered for participants.

Badges

Badges issued on the basis of accreditation will be distributed at the conference venue prior to the conference on 4 September.





Arrival and departure

All guests are kindly asked to organize their transport to and from Tallinn International Airport. We would like to inform you, that due to the reconstruction works, Tallinn Airport is closed to incoming flights from 0:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. on certain nights of the week (probably including 3 September) and the delayed flights will be redirected to other airports. Therefore, we advise to avoid, if possible, very late flights. A taxi stand can be found just outside the arrivals hall. The fare from the airport to the city centre is about €5 to €10. For the bus line No. 2, please check the website of the Tallinn Airport: <http://www.tallinn-airport.ee/en/transport/leaving-the-airport/>. The nearest bus station to Nordic Hotel Forum is A. Laikmaa (both directions, approx. 200 meters from the hotel). At the airport, please make sure that the bus runs direction Reisisadam (city), not direction Mõigu.

Participants are responsible for booking and paying for their accommodation. The conference organiser has made a pre-reservation in Nordic Hotel Forum.
